Giving Hope Empowerment Project

Training in farming, animal husbandry, vocational skills, income-generating activities, HIV/AIDS education, health and hygiene. The training frees orphans from poverty and dependency within 2-3 years in the program.

Relief Ministry

Including food, school fees, clothing, clean water, and medical care.

Every 14 seconds a child in Africa becomes an orphan due to HIV/AIDS and when this happens, the burden of care falls to elderly family members and the oldest sibling left behind—all of them trapped in poverty. Children as young as 10-13 years old are the sole providers for their families. Because of the fear and misinformation surrounding HIV/AIDS, the children whose parents have died are frequently subject to stigmatization by their community.

ZOE Ministry is giving hope. ZOE reaches out to orphans and vulnerable children who have been suffering in isolation, through the **empowerment program** and **relief aid** for orphans and vulnerable children.
