Jean Damascene of Rwanda was 14 years old when his mother died, leaving him to raise three siblings. Before meeting ZOE, Jean was unable to successfully farm his land. He and his family went hungry most of the time, so Jean left home and began living on the streets.

ZOE Ministry provided start-up training and funding for Jean's business of growing beans, rice, and sorghum, all for less than two hundred dollars. A year and a half later, Jean had harvested nearly a thousand dollars worth of food.
