Graduations

In 2009, ZOE will celebrate the first group of Giving Hope Graduates. Over 800 families totaling over 2,700 orphans in Kenya and Rwanda are taking the next steps into the future God has for them. Equipped with essential life skills, they now have the ability to live free from the cycle of poverty and dependency.

Expanded Impact

ZOE is adding 1,391 new Giving Hope families to the ministry in Kenya and Rwanda. This will reach orphans and families suffering alone without the support of hope and empowerment.
